**Alpacas: \$15.50 for first exhibit, \$5.50 for subsequent entries -
includes entry, parking and Show Program**

Fleeces: \$ 5.50 per exhibit. All entry fees are inclusive of GST.

The Colac Alpaca Show 2008 is bound by the Showing Rules of the Australian Alpaca Association.

Exhibitors should note that this Show will not have a certificate of compliance under the National Johnnes Disease MAP program. However, clean straw and carpet bedding will be provided by the Colac P & A Society for pens, or exhibitors may bring their own bedding if they wish. Assessed and non-assessed animals will be separated in pens and entry to the pavilion.

All alpacas entered must be registered with the Australian Alpaca Association, and carry an approved brass tag showing the animal's IAR number.

Wethers may be a registered or unregistered alpaca. No wether may have any visible genetic faults and must be castrated.

Alpacas are to be penned by 8.30am Sunday, 2nd November. Exhibitors must be in attendance at time of inspection. Inspection of all alpacas will commence at 8.30am. Any animal not penned ready for inspection will be disqualified. - Judging will start promptly at 9.30am. Alpacas are to remain at the show grounds until 4.00pm.

Alpacas must carry a minimum fleece length of 5cm. It is recommended that maximum fleece length be no more than 13cms

Correct Animal Colour Classifications:

An alpaca is to be shown in the appropriate colour class, when it is **predominantly that colour**. Any colour variations will be assessed at the Judge's discretion.

A **fancy** alpaca is to be shown in a fancy class if it has an unusual or striking distribution of colour eg. different coloured blanket markings.

A predominantly **grey** alpaca (grey, rose grey/roan) is to be shown in a grey class, whether or not it has any other coloured spots present, and any colour variations will be assessed at the Judge's discretion.

Age of Alpaca: Alpacas must be entered into the correct class at their age on the actual day of the show.

Chief Steward: The Chief Steward or Official Inspector has the ultimate power to classify all entries for colour, and to inspect each exhibit for identity and any disqualifying faults. The Chief Steward or Official Inspector has the power to transfer an exhibit to another class if deemed appropriate in his/her opinion.

The combining of classes due to insufficient entries or late withdrawals is at the complete discretion of the Chief Steward. (It is desirable to have at least three (3) entries per class)

Exhibitors' Meeting:

The Chief Steward requests that all exhibitors attend a meeting in the show ring at 9.15am.

Dress Code: White coats to be worn in the show ring and exhibitor's attire must be neat and tidy.

Exhibitors must keep allocated pens clean, and give proper attention to their stock throughout the show. Exhibitors must provide their own feed, and feed and water containers. Display/Promotional Alpacas will not be permitted.

It is permitted that promotional material, excluding sales brochures/lists, be displayed from the start of the show. This material must not obstruct walkways in any way and is to be on or within the confines of the breeder's pen.

Stud names are permitted, but must be contained to the bounds of the pen and to a maximum height of 1500mm.

Display of ribbons and trophies from other shows is prohibited.

FLEECES: All fleece entries must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor. Only one fleece that has been shorn in the 18 months prior to the Show may be shown from any one animal. Entries are to be blanket area only, properly skirted and reasonably clean. It is recommended that fleeces be sent in bags made of satin or similar material, or heavy duty plastic. Plastic garbage bags should be avoided.

Exhibits to be lodged with the Fleece Steward by 8.30am.

Note: Huacaya 12 months and older must be shorn regularly so that no more than 15 months fleece is carried at the time of showing.
