Animal and fleece show classes include Huacaya and Suri. All requirements to meet Alpaca MAP requirements will be adhered to and an Exhibition Venue Audit will be completed prior to the event.

Please indicate if you require a copy of the Audit Certificate for your records.

To help us accommodate the large number of entries expected again this year, please indicate your penning requirements on the entry form. For example, are you exhibiting on behalf of several stud names? Do you prefer to pen your animals in groups rather than separately?

Early arrival (Friday 18 June between 3 and 7pm) is fine **provided** you advise the Convenor of your expected time of arrival.

We will attempt to arrange inspections on arrival.

Due to increasing space restrictions, and in line with the requirements of the National Show and similar requirements in other Regions, sanctions will be imposed on exhibitors who fail to exhibit animals entered, if an acceptable explanation is not provided to the Show Committee via the Convenor.

- **Fleeces must be lodged with the Fleece Steward by 8:30am on Saturday 19 June**
- **Judging of Suris will start on Saturday 19 June at 9:30 am sharp.**
- **Judging of Huacayas will start on completion of Suris and will be continued at 9:30am on Sunday 20 June.**
- **Premier Colours will be judged immediately after judging of Supreme Suri or Huacaya.**
- **Presentations will be made after completion of all Judging.**
- **There will be no Exhibitors' meeting – changes to the program will be advised on the noticeboard.**

In addition to the Show program, we are encouraging a vibrant trade involvement by offering trade pens and discounted trade stands. Sales from trade pens may include animals and product. Provided there is sufficient space the trade pens will be interspersed with the show pens on the arena floor. The trade stands are located on the concourse overlooking the arena. We expect craft and spinning demonstrations will again be included.

The show ring will again be located centrally this year to help focus activity within the pavilion and ease the marshalling efforts of exhibitors. To that end walkways must be kept clear! No personal items (eg. chairs, displays, etc) will be permitted in the walkways.

Following previous years' success, the venue of the AlpacaFest Dinner will again be the Werribee RSL, where we can enjoy a three-course meal in the warmth of their facilities.

The Wyndham Information Centre has advised a new internet facility. The website is www.visitwyndham.com.au The website, or phone (03) 9742 0906, will provide answers to your questions about accommodation and local facilities. (e.g. The Comfort Inn is 2 minutes walking distance from the RSL).

Conditions of Entry

This Show will be conducted under the Rules of the Australian Alpaca Association Ltd. as set out in the current AAA Ltd. Showing Rules Manual.

All exhibitors should read the conditions (1 -4) on the entry form and ensure that they can comply with those conditions before signing the entry form, particularly noting the condition dealing with animal health. A separate health declaration will be provided for signature and return with the entry form. Failure to sign the entry form will render all alpacas of an exhibitor ineligible to be exhibited. Please note that only the registered owner of an exhibit, or his/her authorised agent may sign an entry form. The registered owner of an exhibit must be a financial member of the AAA Ltd. Alpacas travelling interstate must comply with that State's Department of Industry requirements.

Period of Exhibition

Alpacas must be penned by 8 am on Saturday 19 June 2009 at the Equestrian Centre, Werribee and may not be removed from the pavilion before 3:30pm or such earlier time as may be announced by the show convener on Sunday 20 June 2009.

All exhibitors are required to assist in the removal and re-packing of panels and other show set-up items before they depart from the show premises.

Preparation of Exhibits and Cleanliness of Stalls

Exhibitors must keep the pens allotted to their animals clean, and give proper attention to their stock throughout the Show. Exhibitors must provide their own feed, and feed and water containers. **Exhibitors must not vary their pen allocation without the approval of the Chief Steward.**

Rubbish

The cost of removing rubbish from the pavilion is enormous.

- Rubbish such as cups, cans, paper, metal, and similar matter **MUST** be placed in the bins provided.
- Straw from animal pens **MUST NOT** BE PLACED IN WHEELIE BINS but **MUST** be placed in the skip located outside the pavilion.

Exhibitors **MUST NOT MIX** straw cleaned from pens with other rubbish.

Advertising

Promotional material is permitted within the bounds of the pen and, at the rear of the pen, to a height of 1500mm. Sale signs are not permitted. Stud names are permitted. Display of Show ribbons awarded at a Show held at another venue is prohibited. Nothing may be displayed which may interfere with a walkway.

A handler shall be deemed to be incorrectly attired if his/her dress or the animal being led displays any information capable of being construed as advertising for any stud.

Companion animals and dogs

Special permission to bring a companion alpaca must be obtained from the Convenor or Chief Steward before submitting the entry form, otherwise no companion alpacas will be permitted. No dogs are permitted into the precinct where Show animals are being penned or shown in the ring. Guide Dogs are exempt.

Inspection of Exhibits

All alpacas (now including wethers) must be registered with the Australian Alpaca Association Ltd. and carry an approved brass tag showing the alpaca's IAR number.

No animal shall be eligible for exhibition if it is not entire (except for wethers). All genitalia shall be complete, properly formed and proportioned for normal reproduction.

The Convenor, in consultation with the Show Committee of a Show conducted under Association Rules, shall appoint a person, or persons, as a qualified inspector, or inspectors, who shall inspect all alpacas for genetic faults, colour class and IAR number and visible physical disfigurement.

NOTE: If there is no IAR tag present in the ear of an animal exhibit, official Association confirmation must be provided by the owner to the Chief Steward that the ear tag has been recently lost and that a new tag has been ordered and paid for. Replacement tag orders and payments must be lodged with the National Office a minimum of one week before the date of the show. Failure to present such advice at inspection will result in disqualification of the animal.

The Inspector or Chief Steward will classify all entries for age, sex and colour and has the power to transfer an exhibit to the class which, in his/her opinion, it should have been entered. The Chief Steward will combine or split classes as he/she sees fit.

The inspection of all alpacas will start at 8 am on Saturday 19 June 2009.

Alpacas not in their allocated pens and available for inspection at the official time may be disqualified by the Chief Steward. Exhibitors must be in attendance at the time of the inspection and will be required to assist.

Exhibits of huacayas must carry a minimum fleece length of 50 mm and a recommended maximum length not exceeding 130 mm. The minimum fleece length for suris is 75 mm and fleece length will be assessed by the Judge.

Exhibits shall not have fleece of a different colour to that of the blanket removed from an animal to a level below that of the blanket fleece.

Any alpaca found to have lice infestation must be removed from the showgrounds immediately along with any other alpacas present that belong to the same exhibitor.

Penning

All exhibitors shall, on the day of the Show, obtain their pen position and animal exhibit card numbers from the Shed Steward. The animal exhibit number card of the exhibit must be worn and clearly displayed by the handler whilst in the show ring. The age of the alpaca, in months, will be displayed on the card.

All exhibitors must place their animals in the pens allotted by the Show Stewards and must not be moved or removed except by order of the Chief Steward.

Sires Progeny

Sires Progeny classes will be offered for both Huacaya and Suri for two progeny from a sire.

There must be at least two entries in order for the class to be conducted. The progeny may be males and/or females but cannot include wethers. The progeny need not be owned or bred by the one exhibitor, however they must be drawn from the ordinary age based classes - ie all progeny must have been entered as animal exhibits in AlpacaFest 2010. Entries will be made on the day.

Only one progeny from any one dam may be shown in each sires progeny class unless the progeny have been born at least eleven months apart.

Fans

While many breeders are keen to use fans to keep their alpacas dry, the provision does create a range of issues for organisers. OH&S rules require that no leads are on the ground -even if covered - and all leads MUST have a current tag showing they have been checked by a qualified electrician. Power outlets must be arranged with adequate supply.

Only breeders who have indicated on their entry forms that they wish to bring and use a fan and have paid the designated fee per fan may do so. Fans must be presented to the Electrical Services Steward for checking and tagging prior to their use, and only designated power outlets may be used.

The availability of power for fans cannot, of course, be guaranteed as it depends on the overall power supply made available for the competition. Every effort will be made to satisfy requests for power supply for fans.

It is intended that exterior doors will, with appropriate barriers, remain open overnight to ensure best possible ventilation throughout the pavilion.

Security

A security person will be on duty in the pavilion overnight. No-one will be admitted to the pavilion between its close on Friday night and 5:00am Saturday morning, or 8:00pm on Saturday evening and 5:00am on Sunday morning.

Supreme and Premier Colour

In "Age Championship" shows, AAA rules provide for the judging of the Supreme Huacaya and Suri from the winners of each appropriate type age section. "Best of Colour" may be judged after determination of the Supreme Huacaya or Suri from the first placed animals in the various colours.

AlpacaFest, as an "Age Championship" show, will award Supreme Huacaya / Suri to the animal adjudged the best from the champions for each age section.

Each Age class Champion will also be awarded a bag of Laucke Mills Alpaca Blend.

Additionally, AlpacaFest will judge and award the best male/female from the first placed alpacas for each colour category, *except the colour of the animal awarded Supreme Huacaya or Suri*, and the Best of Colour - to be awarded "**Premier**" colour - will be adjudged from the best male and female for the particular colour.

The winner of **Supreme Huacaya** and **Supreme Suri** will automatically be declared **Premier** colour for their colour, and will also receive the prize of 1 large Show Fleece bag and 1 Driden Oilskin and blanket Cria Coat courtesy of **Brumosa Azul**.

The description of animal colours is as follows:

White: constitutes a pristine bright white fleece.

Light fawn: alpacas with a cream or off white fleece or have light fawn on the neck or backline. (NB Animals with light fawn on the neck or backline should be entered and shown in the light fawn class)

Grey: A predominantly grey alpaca is to be shown in a grey class, whether or not it has any other coloured spots present and any colour variations will be assessed at the Judge's discretion. The grey classes will include light greys, medium greys, dark greys and rose greys.

A **Roan** alpaca is a fawn, brown or black with a significant amount of white fibres throughout the fleece. A roan usually appears externally to be a solid fawn, brown or black, until the fleece is opened, at which time the white fibres are visible and uniformly interspersed throughout the blanket of the fleece. Alpacas with these characteristics should be entered and shown in a roan class.

Judging

A competitor may not discuss with the Judge their alpacas or proposed exhibits before or during the Show judging.

The Judge's decision shall be final. He/she may choose not to award a prize or prizes in a class.

All handlers showing animals must be competent in the handling of their exhibit, or removal from the ring may be requested by the Judge. It is recommended that small children not exhibit large animals that they cannot control.

Handlers must wear and clearly display the animal exhibit number card while in the judging ring. The age of the alpaca and the age of the fleece, in months, must be displayed on the card.

Dress code in judging ring

All attendants leading stock in the judging ring or parade shall wear a white coat over dark coloured, preferably **black**, long trousers or long skirts, with clean **black** dress shoes or boots. Hats may not be worn in the judging ring. The Chief Steward may disqualify an exhibitor for incorrect attire.

Fleeces

All fleeces being exhibited (including wether fleeces) must be the bona fide property of an AAA Ltd. financial member and must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.

Only one fleece that has been shorn in the 18 months before the Show may be shown from any one animal. It is recommended that fleeces be placed in bags, made of satin or similar material, or heavy duty plastic. Plastic garbage bags should be avoided.

Exhibitors, when submitting fleeces at the Show, must attach to the fleece the number supplied for that class (no names).
