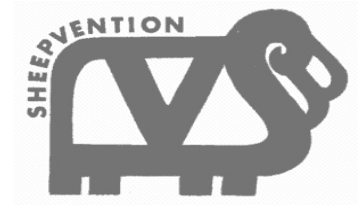

Animal and fleece show classes include Huacaya and Suri. All requirements to meet Alpaca MAP requirements will be adhered to and an Exhibition Venue Audit will be completed prior to the event.

### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

1. This Show will be conducted under the Rules of the Australian Alpaca Association as set out in the current AAA Showing Rules Manual and the General Regulations of the Hamilton P. & A. Society Inc, as noted in the 2011 Sheep Show Schedule. In the event of any inconsistency, the General Regulations shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency.
2. All exhibitors should read the conditions on the entry form and ensure that they can comply with them before signing the entry form. One entry form per Exhibitor. Failure to sign the entry form will render all alpacas of an exhibitor ineligible to be exhibited. Please note that only the registered owner of an exhibit, or his/her authorised agent may sign an entry form.
3. All alpacas must be registered with the Australian Alpaca Association and carry an approved brass tag showing the alpaca's IAR number. All Exhibitors must be current members of AAA Ltd and the Hamilton P. & A. Society Inc.
4. Each alpaca entered must be registered on the IAR database. Details for each animal must be available from the AAA Members Section IAR online database at the time of entry..

### **ENTRY FEES:**

#### **\$50 Membership (Hamilton P. & A. Society Inc.)**

Membership covers two passes (Member & Guest) for both days of Sheepvention 2011 & Beef Expo (Feb 2012).

**\$15 per Animal Entry \$10 per Fleece Entry** (all Entry Fees inclusive of GST).

Payable "Hamilton Sheepvention".

### **ENTRIES CLOSE 4th July**

ALLOCATION: In 2011 there will be no limitation on entries, both animals and fleeces.

In line with the requirements of the National Show and similar requirements in other Regions, sanctions will be imposed on exhibitors who fail to exhibit animals entered, if an acceptable explanation is not provided to the Show Committee via the Convenor.

### **PERSONAL OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATION**

Exhibitors must make their own arrangements. There are several caravan parks, motels and hotels in the vicinity of the Showgrounds and Home Hosting accommodation is also available. **AGE OF ALPACA**

The reference date for determining the age of an alpaca is Monday 1 August 2011.

The following table shows the dates between which the alpaca's date of birth must occur in order for the alpaca to be eligible for the age class:

6 months to under 12 months	born between	2 August 2010 and 1 Feb 2011
12 months to under 18 months		2 Feb 2010 and 1 August 2010
18 months to under 30 months		2 Feb 2009 and 1 Feb 2010
24 months to under 36 months		2 August 2008 and 1 August 2009
30 months to under 48 months		1 Aug 2007 and 1 Feb 2009
36 months and over	born before	2 Aug 2008
48 months and over	born before	2 Aug 2007

For determining the age class for a fleece in the Fleece show, the age of the alpaca on the date at which the fleece was shorn must lie in the relevant age category:

**Huacaya fleece**

- 6 months to under 12 months
- 12 months to under 18 months
- 18 months to under 30 months
- 30 months to under 48 months
- 48 months to under 60 months
- 60 months and over

**Suri fleece**

- 6 months to under 18 months
- 18 months to under 30 months
- 30 months and over

Prize Cards, Ribbons (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>) may be awarded to placegetters in their Classes and Society Sashes to all Champions, Reserves & Bests.

**EXHIBITOR NOTES:**

**All Alpacas to enter the Showgrounds via the Lions Club Pavilion, with roller door access direct from Shakespeare St (Cnr. Horner St). These doors will be opened from Midday on Sunday 31st July.**

**Parking for floats is available along the Showgrounds side of Shakespeare St.**

Show Documentation will be available on arrival.

**Alpacas are to be penned on Sunday 31st July by 4pm.**

**Inspection** of all alpacas will commence promptly at **4.15pm** and any alpaca not penned ready for inspection, with Exhibitor in attendance, may be disqualified. The Chief/Inspection Steward will classify all entries for colour; to inspect each exhibit for identity and any disqualifying faults and to transfer an exhibit to another class if deemed appropriate in his/her opinion.

Any alpaca found to have lice infestation must be removed from the showgrounds immediately along with any other alpacas present belonging to the same exhibitor.

The Chief Steward may combine or split classes as he/she sees fit.

Only first placed alpacas are eligible for "Best" Awards.

**Monday 1st August: 9.30am Exhibitors Meeting with Chief Steward.  
10am Judging commences.**

**Handlers Dress Code: White Coats, dark trousers or skirt, clean dark coloured dress shoes or boots, no hats.**

**Alpaca & Fleece Judge: AAA accredited**

**Alpacas must remain until 4.30pm Tuesday 2nd August.**

As in past years, Exhibitors' assistance with dismantling of pens is required and appreciated. 15 minutes from everyone ensures an excellent participant profile from the "alpaca" people at Sheepvention.

- Exhibitor's responsibility to complete pen cleaning by 8:30am daily and provide their own feed, and feed & water containers, giving proper attention to their stock throughout the show.
- No alpacas to be tethered to any penning or perimeter exercise area. Alpacas on leads must be under handler control at all times.
- Pen size 8' x 8', pen straw provided. Pen allocation allows for up to 4 alpacas per pen.
- Alpacas may only be exercised within the designated Alpaca areas appropriate to your exhibit's health status.
